




Call for applications Doc.Mobility@unibas 2023



Mobility grants for doctoral students

The call is aimed at doctoral students from the University of Basel who wish to strengthen their scientific network at a research institute abroad. The mobility grants enable a research stay of 6–12 months abroad in order to deepen scientific knowledge and to advance the doctoral thesis.

Who can apply for a grant?

All doctoral students of the University of Basel who have been enrolled at the University of Basel for 2 semesters prior to the submission of the application and who do not already have funding from the Swiss National Science Foundation. A stay at the partner university as part of a cotutelle de thèse is not possible.

What can be applied for?

Doc.Mobility@unibas includes a contribution to cover the costs of living abroad, calculated according to family status and chosen place of residence, a lump sum for travel expenses and a contribution to possible conference costs. The funding period is 6 to 12 months.

How is the evaluation carried out?

The criteria are scientific qualifications of the applicant, the quality of the research project to be carried out during the research stay and the mobility benefits of the intended research location.

When can applications be submitted?

Applications can be submitted electronically by 1 March and 1 September (both at 5 pm). The earliest possible start of the stay abroad is the following 1 June or 1 December.
